

RESONANCE- Medicinal cannabis on quality of life and symptom control in advanced cancer

“People are very interested in medicinal cannabis but we don't know enough about how it helps. We have a trial that involves prescribing cannabis and monitoring patients' responses and feedback on it. Would you like to know more about it?”

What does the study involve?

1) Patients are randomly assigned to a group who will receive either

Cannabis Oil

Placebo

2) Take medications from Day 1 to Day 169

Total 11 visits to the hospital clinical trial centre until the end of treatment.

3) Willing and able to comply with all study requirements, blood sampling and other assessments (eg: Driving is prohibited).

4) Life expectancy > 2 months. ECOG 0-2 or AKPS 60
