

NAMISOL- Medicinal cannabis- Tetrahydrocannabinol (THC) for stimulating appetite in advanced cancer.

"People are very interested in medicinal cannabis and we don't know enough about how it helps with your appetite. We have a trial that looks at whether cannabis improves appetite in advanced cancer. Would you like to know more about it?"

What does the study involve?

1) Patient are randomly assigned to a group who will receive either



THC tablet



Placebo tablet

- 2) Advanced cancer. Anorexia for at least 2 weeks.
- 3) Take medication (tablet) from Day 1 to Day 28. Total 5 visits to hospital & 3 telephone call.
- 4) Willing and able to comply with all study requirement, blood, urine sampling and other assessment (eg: food diary, driving is prohibited).
- 5) No history of psychiatric disorder, severe depression, suicidality, schizophrenia, cognitive impairment, unstable cardiovascular disease, delirium within <30 days.
